The Old Gal's Tips

**Mix 1 Tbsp. of Epson salts into soil at bottom of planting hole before planting tomatoes and peppers.

**Don't bother spreading egg shells around your Hostas to ward off slugs. Experts have proven it doesn't work! Instead crush shells finely—the finer the better and add to your composter.

**Vinegar can be used to kill weeds. Spray with cleaning or horticulture vinegar. Be careful spraying near your plants as it is non-selective—you could kill them too. Great for walkways—between pavers.
